

Walkathon held to mark World Forestry Day

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A walkathon was held at the Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (IFGTB) on Thursday to mark the World Forestry Day, March 21.

The primary objective of the 'Awareness Walk Rally' was to raise awareness about the importance of forests and encourage individuals to engage in Mission LiFE initiatives.

C Kunhikannan, Director, ICFRE-IFGTB, inaugurated the programme. In his inaugural address, he highlighted the multifaceted benefits bestowed by forests, stressing their pivotal role in sustaining life on Earth. (ICFRE is the Indian
