District Forest Officer Venkateshwar Reddy explained about the maintenance of reserve forest and nurseries to the visiting officials.

He informed that as many as 30,000 saplings were grown in the nurseries for carrying out plantation in the reserve forest and check dams, farm ponds and recharging pits were constructed in 50 hectares of reserve forest to harvest the rainwater.

Officials of Central team expressed their pleasure over the measures being taken at reserve forest and planted saplings in the forest land as a mark of their tour.
