

Boise National Forest cancels seedling sale

The Boise National Forest has canceled the annual surplus-seedling sale at its Lucky Peak Nursery northeast of Boise due to COVID-19 concerns.

The decision to cancel the sale, originally scheduled April 4-30, follows Gov. Brad Little's statewide 21-day stay-at-home order.

National forest managers said in a statement they hope to provide surplus seedlings next year.

The nursery serves the Intermountain West, producing more than 3 million one- and two-year-old trees and shrubs. Landowners buy them for windbreaks, habitat improvement and other uses.
