Harishchandra ghat trees to be preserved with platforms: DC

Varanasi: Divisional commissioner Kaushal Raj Sharma on Saturday inspected redevelopment work being done at Harishchandra Ghat. Some changes in the proposed model were given priority for the convenience of public.

He also directed the executing agency to complete the work within the stipulated time period.
