

Mumbai suburbs get 'urban forest' with Miyawaki method

Bhakti park in Mumbai's eastern suburb Wadala was just a regular park till last year but the BMC decided to turn a part of the park into a city forest grown with a unique technique called the 'Miyawaki Method'. So far the 57,000 trees planted in this urban forest in Bhakti Park using the Miyawaki concept are flourishing fast...and BMC officials plan to expand the initiative covering up to 75 areas in the coming years. According to experts it takes a century to develop a forest in a conventional way but with this Japanese technique mini forests grow 10 times faster and become 30 times denser.
