

Senapati Forest Division observes Van Mahotsav 12 July 2020



Senapati, Jul 13: Creating awareness to conserve forest and plant new trees, the Senapati Forest Division organised a tree plantation program as part of 71st Van Mahotsav celebration at different places of the Senapati district.

Speaking at the outset of the programme, Lalithambigai, IAS, DC, Senapati said that the day marks to create awareness among the people on the importance of conserving forest and planting trees which would benefit the people in many ways.

Trees help in reducing pollution, combating global warming, reducing soil erosion etc he said. The DC asserted that it is one's foremost responsibility to protect and conserve the forests as well as plant more trees.

As part of developmental program, the DC requested all to plant 10,000 trees this year.
